STUDY FOLK DANCE IN TOBO FOR ONE YEAR!

This is a course which is aimed at people who have danced folk dance in some form or another previously. The principal teachers on the course, Ami and Andreas, are some of Sweden's leading folk dance pedagogues, and all three have great experience of teaching dance. The course mixes practical dance with theory and much focus is placed on deepening and developing your dancing, both regarding repertoire and more in-depth qualities. During the course you will also have the chance to explore and put into practice different types of teaching for dance, as well as producing productions together with the students from the Folk Music course. The course gives you a good base from which to pursue studies at university or conservatoire level.

The course has been held by the Eric Sahlström Institute since 2004, and has an important collaboration with the Folk Music course for nyckelharpa/violin. The Institute's large hall is not just a beautiful environment to be in, it is also unusually well-suited as a space in which to teach dance.

During the year you will have the opportunity to meet with several guest teachers. The Eric Sahlström Institute also acts as a centre for folk music and dance in Sweden, and therefore you will also have the chance to meet many well-known profiles within the genre who come to visit. The course takes place in the historic Jaktslottet (built in 1888-89) in the beautiful surroundings of Tobo, just north of Uppsala.
